District receives \$78,488 incentive check for energy efficiency project and benefits from more than \$200,000, on average, in annual energy savings

Some of the measures included replacing boilers, installing advanced energy management systems (EMS) district-wide, replacing steam traps, enhancing building envelope, and replacing lighting systems district-wide. The infrastructure upgrades were designed to deliver greater energy efficiency and operational cost savings, enhanced comfort for building occupants, and reduced greenhouse gasses and emissions, while also supporting the District's commitment to social responsibility and environmental stewardship.

"This guaranteed energy savings performance project reflects our commitment to energy conservation, including reducing our operating costs and achieving our sustainability goals," said Dr. Lois Powell, District Superintendent. "Our contract with Ameresco allowed us to replace our aging infrastructure and upgrade our buildings. The project includes efficiency measures that we expect will continue to deliver over \$200,000 in annual energy savings, on average, benefiting the schools and local community for years to come."
