- WHAT: A ribbon-cutting and tour of the Northeast Water Pollution Control Plant's (NEWPCP) new Biogas Cogeneration Facility. This waste biogas-to-energy facility will generate electricity and thermal energy for on-site use and will reduce carbon emissions by 22,000 tons per year, which is equivalent to 4,833 cars off the road or 2.84 million gallons of gasoline.
