In the spring of 2009, Ameresco was awarded a \$795 million contract by the Department of Energy (DOE) to construct the biomass cogeneration facility and two smaller biomass heating facilities at the DOE’s Savannah River Site. Under the terms of the contract, Ameresco will finance, design, construct, operate, maintain and fuel the new biomass facilities for the DOE for the next 20 years.
